McGrath work closely with construction logistics company, the Munnelly Group, to provide synchronised collections of wastes generated by construction projects in the capital including the Walkie-Talkie building (Fenchurch Street) and Rathbone Market regeneration (Canning Town).

Our sophisticated traffic management systems enable daily collections of segregated and general construction wastes to be fulfilled despite severe limitations on time and space that often accompany sites in Central London.

Materials collected and sorted on-site by Munnelly Group operatives are tipped into labelled skips and wheelie bins provided by McGrath.

Collection slots are booked online via Munnelly's Delivery Management System (DMS) and fulfilled by McGrath's logistics team. Incorporation of traffic management technology such as GPS tracking and route planning software enable us to coordinate and manage the collection process to maximise the efficiency of the logistics operation and provide a complete audit trail of waste.

Wastes are transported to McGrath's Materials Recycling Facility (MRF) in Hackney where they are sorted and segregated using automatic and manual methods into individual wastes streams for recycling.
