However, with lockdown easing, many firms are looking to reclaim their space and create an environment fit for the workforce again.

Sustainability is central to the workplace change services provided by Crown Workspace. They operate an award-winning furniture and IT refurbishment centre to allow the reuse of quality used assets where feasible, offered as a buy-back or resale service. Moreover, Crown Workspace's Giving Back Project – a long-standing donation initiative – donated over 4,000 assets to charities and schools UK-wide in 2020. These efforts have both economic and environmental benefits, reducing Scope 3 emissions as well as supporting those in need while delivering wider social value.

As part of their commitment, Crown Workspace provide a comprehensive client savings report, outlining a project's financial, environmental, and social savings achieved through the reuse of furniture.

For true end-of-life items, McGrath Bros. (Waste Control) Ltd. provide the most sustainable option, with items such as old furniture tipped at the MRF and sorted. Upon arrival by Crown Workspace, most commonly by their own HGV fleet, the furniture is broken down by hand to ensure that all elements are sorted correctly. Some items, however, have found a new lease of life at McGrath Bros. (Waste Control) Ltd. own offices.

A recent extension to McGrath Bros. (Waste Control) Ltd. own office space required extra furniture, and in the spirit of reducing and reusing, Crown Workspace items were put to good use. Every endeavour is made to donate to local charities where possible, however, due to Crown Workspace's impressive sustainability programme it is rare to find a good example by the time it's received at the MRF.

Any plastic elements of the furniture are decontaminated upon segregation by a mixture of cyclones and water baths before being shredded, melted and granulated ready to be manufactured into new items. Elsewhere, timber and wood can either be salvaged if whole and donated to charitable projects and social enterprises, or our state-of-the-art timber recycling facility where it is loaded into industrial high performance shredders.

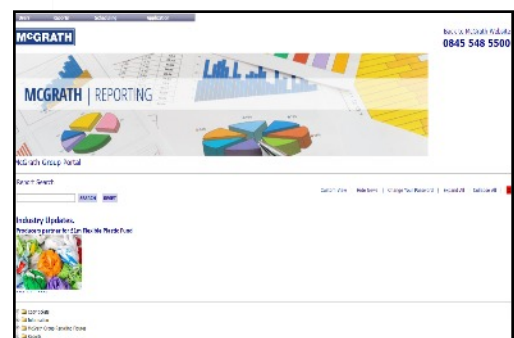
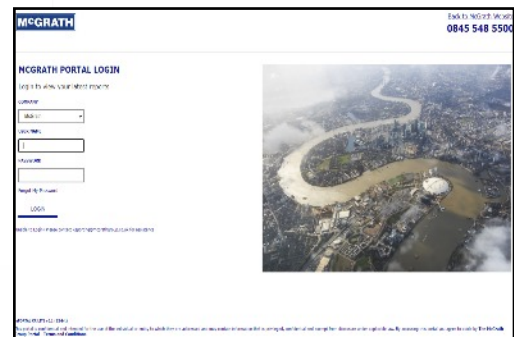
