



Cory

Cory is one of the UK's leading recycling and waste management companies. It operates one of the biggest energy from waste (EFW) facilities in the country, located on the banks of the River Thames in London. Cory transports waste by a fleet of tugs and barges on the River Thames and turns around 750,000 tonnes of London and the South East's non-recyclable waste into baseload electricity. This diverts the waste from landfill and helps to power the region by generating more than 500 GWh of electricity each year.

Since 2017, McGrath has been working with Cory on the disposal of municipal waste for the London Borough of Tower Hamlets. Cory operates a Waste Transfer Station and Household Waste & Recycling Centre at Northumberland Wharf, sending around 75,000 tonnes of recyclable and non-recyclable waste for processing per year. A proportion of the recyclable waste is sent to McGrath's Materials Recycling Facility (MRF) and the non-recyclable waste is transported by barge to Cory's EFW facility.

Recyclable waste that is brought to McGrath's MRF is sorted both mechanically and by hand into the individual waste streams before being sent for recycling. Our 24-hour facility and automatic weighbridges ensure a continual service for Cory and the London Borough of Tower Hamlets.
